JDP Day #1 - Saturday August 24

I will be ringing everyone when I have time during the week. In the meantime, attached to this email is some paperwork that needs to be completed on the first day. If you haven't completed it already, please complete everything before the first day as it will speed everything along.

- If you have CAMS membership, bring proof of membership along
- Or if you do not have CAMS membership, complete the Tarmac JDP Assoc of SA membership form
- L2S CAMS licence application (if you answer yes to any of the medical questions, Please contact me ASAP)
- Photo disclaimer/social media form
- event entry

Also attached are **the Sup Regulations** and **event schedule**. Make sure you read the Supp regulations.

I would also like to remind everyone that participants need to war clothing from ankles to neck to wrists (flammable synthetic material, such as nylon, is not acceptable) and enclosed shoes. If you have your own helmet, feel free to bring it.

Someone will also take some individual photos and a couple group photos some time during the day.

The aim of the program is to prepare you for future competition so I'm going to be pretty strict with making sure everyone completes the documentation one would expect at a normal motorsport event.

To help with the classroom activity, can you research the following

- Why do we have the JDP
- Some "grass roots" tarmac events
- List some circuit racing categories (open wheelers and sedans)
- Who are CAMS and what they do?

Last Saturday we held a maintenance day at Tailem Bend Motor Sport Park on the cars we already have down there.

Beware, even though it is not yet a requirement of the JDP, I will be expecting each participant (and a parent) to **spend a day as an official** at an event at Mallala. You learn a bucket load of what goes on behinds the scenes at a motorsport event and get to appreciate the work and effort our volunteer officials do. CAMS run a Junior Official Program at Australian F1 GP and rounds of the V8 supercars so I will be letting everyone know when applications for the 2014 Clipsal 500 CAMS Junior Official Program open.

The South Australian Motor Racing Officials Association (SAMROA) have planned a **First Aid Course on Sunday 22 September**. This is professionally conducted by First Aid Pro and the venue will be confirmed soon, most likely the Sporting Car Club. This course is appropriate for all ages including new comers & those looking to renew their qualifications. I feel it's a good idea to get as many learner drivers as possible to learn first aid before they get out on the road by themselves. You will qualify as a Senior First Aider, which would be of benefit just in your normal daily life. Cost is \$100. Contact Darren for more details.
