



Welcome to the October Newsletter.

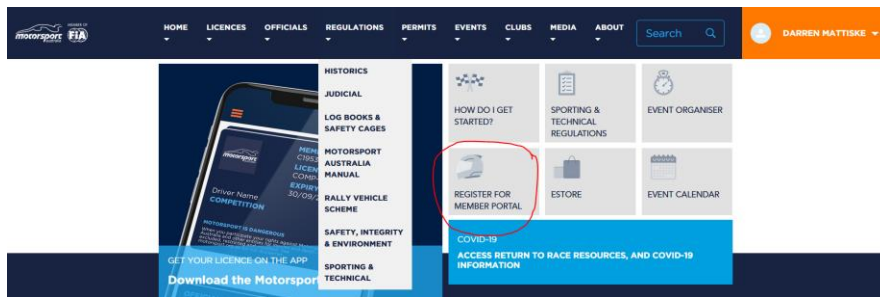
Day #3 is Sun 14th November and proudly supported by Safe Fire Electrical who supplies all of our fire extinguishers.
